

LIMUD – TEMPLE BETH HILLEL’S NEW INDEPENDENT LEARNING PROGRAM

Temple Beth Hillel Religious School seeks to meet the needs of our learners and their families. Therefore, we are launching a new program that we hope will meet the needs of our families **and** fulfill the requirements of our congregation for supplementary learning, including the requirements for a child to become bar/bat Mitzvah. LIMUD is a supplementary learning program, like Religious School, that offers a greater degree of flexibility for families. To participate in LIMUD, families must be members in good standing of Temple Beth Hillel, sign the *Brit* (covenant) agreement that outlines the expectations of TBH and the family, and pay the LIMUD fee. LIMUD is available to students in 2nd-6th grades only.

LIMUD families will:

- Student will attend 27 one-hour sessions **at** TBH with their teacher (sessions might be one-on-one or small group depending upon interest and enrollment)
- Family will attend a minimum of 6 Shabbat services throughout the year and write a short description of the service
- Student and an adult will attend the grade-level Family Education Day
- 4th-6th grade students will attend the 4th-6th grade Religious School retreat
- Student will participate in a minimum of 2 youth group events

TEMPLE BETH HILLEL RELIGIOUS SCHOOL will:

- Create curriculum, provide supervision, arrange materials, administer, and hire the teacher for the LIMUD program
